## **INFORMATION ABOUT OUR USE OF COOKIES**

### **What is a cookie?**

**Cookies** are small files which are stored on a user's computer. If you provide your consent to the use of cookies, it allows the website to store a modest amount of data specific to your device and website, which allows the site to recognise your connected application device and store some information about your preferences or past actions, so you can have an improved experience while using this site and during the next time you visit us.

### **Why do we use cookies?**

We use cookies when you connect to our website [www.branstonadams.co.uk](http://www.branstonadams.co.uk) including any mobile or device specific version of the website and any related applications (or "apps") (together the "[www.branstonadams.co.uk](http://www.branstonadams.co.uk)"). Our Website uses first party cookies (e.g. a cookie set by a website or a domain visited by a user) and third-party cookies (e.g. being a cookie set by a website or a domain other than the one visited by the user) to distinguish you from other users. This allows us to provide you with the best possible experience when you browse our Website and helps us to understand how to improve our service even further. For example, certain types of cookies can be very helpful to enable you to navigate between the different pages of our Website efficiently, to remember your preferences and past actions on our Website and to make the interaction between you and our Website quicker and easier. There are also other types of cookies which help us to understand your interests, so we can show you personalised and relevant online advertisements.

### **What type of cookies do we use?**

We use the following cookies:

#### **Strictly Necessary Cookies**

#### **Targeting and Marketing cookies**

- **Strictly Necessary Cookies.** These are cookies that are required for the operation of our Website. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to access and use our Website but also deliver content that works on your device. Without these cookies, you will not be able to use all the service on our Website and if you decide to opt-out from those cookies certain parts of our Website will not work correctly or may not work at all. For example, we use session cookies on our Website to keep you logged into the Website and to avoid you having to login every time you load a game or move to another page.
- **Functionality Cookies.** These cookies enable the features of our Website. They recognise you when you return to our Website and remember the choices you have made such as the selection of your favourite games. This enables us to personalise our content for you and remember your preferences (for example, your favourite pages, your login details when you return to the Website, your sound preference, etc). Without these cookies, you will still be able to use our Website, but your experience may not be as great as it should be, and you may not get the best of our services. You will not see content that is relevant to you.
- **Analytical Cookies.** These types of cookies allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our Website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our Website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily. Without these cookies, you can still use and enjoy all the features of our Website. We also use these cookies to monitor and analyse the ongoing performance of the Website. Sometimes, these cookies will be set by third party providers on our behalf, but we make sure that any provider we work with is careful with this information. This information is fully anonymised which means that a third-party provider knows nothing more about our user's identification other than a number.
- **Targeting and Marketing Cookies.** These cookies record your visit to our Website, the pages you have visited (including, in the case of interest-based advertising, the pages of other websites) and the links you have followed. We use this information to measure the effectiveness of our marketing and to improve the overall relevance of the advertising we buy including, where possible, to make advertising more relevant to you. Without these cookies, you will be able to use and enjoy all the features of our Website but the ads you see will not be tailored to your

## INFORMATION ABOUT OUR USE OF LOCAL STORAGE

### What is local storage?

Browser web storage enables websites to store data in a browser on a device. This technology is similar to cookies in that only non-sensitive data is stored but has a greater storage limit. When web storage is used in "local storage" mode, it enables data to be stored across sessions (meaning that data are retrievable even after the browser window has been closed and reopened). One technology that facilitates web storage (and local storage) is HTML 5.

### What type of properties do we store in local storage?

We use Functionality Properties. These properties enable the features of our Website. They recognise you when you return to our Website and remember the choices you have made, such as the selection of your favourites pages or whether you've enabled notifications. This allows us to personalise our content for you and remember your preferences (for example, sounds notifications, etc). Without these properties, you will still be able to use our Website, but your experience will be more difficult, and you may not get the best out of our services. You will not see content that is relevant to you.
